

Success story: Ugu district in KZN, South Africa

The first district in South Africa to achieve UNAIDS 90-90-90 targets

The Challenge



The Ugu District in the KwaZulu-Natal Province of South Africa has one of the highest HIV infection rates in the world with 27% of the population HIV-positive.



It has an exceptionally high prevalence of HIV amongst pregnant women, with 43.4% being HIV-positive.



The combined efforts of 73 facilities across four municipalities needed to achieve the UNAIDS 90-90-90 targets to help bring the disease into epidemic control.
